Major Duties

- Respond to or direct participant inquiries or concerns.
- Deliver YMCA service responsibly, honestly, respectfully and with care.
- Take action to ensure members are safe when participating at the YMCA.
- Be positive, helpful and welcoming at all times,

Qualifications

- Minimum age 18.
- Volunteers age 16 and above will need to provide a Vulnerable Sector Screening from their local police service before their first day of volunteering.
- Current First Aid/CPR certification.
- AED certification an asset
- Minimum Individual Conditioning Level 1.
- Strong communications skills.
- Team player and initiative.
- Commitment to YMCA Mission, Vision and Values.

Time Commitment

- Minimum one year commitment.
- Flexible schedule.
