

# YMCA OF CENTRAL EAST ONTARIO DAY CAMP

## ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

- All parent(s)/caregiver(s) of a family are required to work outside of the home.
- Once we have confirmed what dates and locations we can offer your family, we will contact you to proceed with details of the registration.

## PICK-UP/DROP-OFF

- Families will be required to drop-off and pick-up at camp.
- Parents will be assigned a drop-off time between 8:00am and 9:30am and pick-up time between 3:45pm and 4:15pm.
- Families must adhere to assigned times for screening purposes.

## SUBSIDY & FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Please contact your multiplicity for further details on applying for subsidy. Financial assistance is available through the YMCA Strong Kids program.

## SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Campers and Staff will be screened at arrival each day of camp.
- Campers will be escorted into the camp space – parents will be asked to remain outside of the space to reduce any risk of exposure.
- If someone begins exhibiting symptoms, they will be removed from their camper group and given a mask to wear. Families will be contacted to pick-up immediately.
- YMCA will be keeping logs of campers and their locations in the event of a COVID-19 positive case. Families who have a camper that has been in contact with the individual testing positive for COVID-19 will be contacted.
- YMCA Day Camps will adhere to enhanced cleaning and strict disinfecting guidelines while operating programs.
- Campers will not be required to wear masks or any other PPE unless physical distancing is unavoidable.

## YMCA DAY CAMP

(Campers 6-12 years old)

Fees: \$185/week, \$148/short week

- Camper groups will consist of 8 campers and 2 counsellors.
- Camper groups will be divided up by age as much as possible, but there will be a bigger age range than in previous years.
- Campers will be grouped by family unit. Multi-aged programming will be designed to meet the interests of the children.
- Each camper group will have a designated indoor and outdoor space.
- Campers will stay with their camper group for the duration of the week. There will not be mixing of camper groups at any time.
- Physical distancing within each camper group will be strongly encouraged during all activities.
- Campers will not be swimming.
- Extended care is not available.
- All day camps closed on Monday August 3, 2020.

9:30am-12:00pm	Campers participate in small group activities with their designated camper group
12:00pm-12:30pm	Lunch
12:30pm-4:00pm	More camp fun with camper group
3:45pm-4:15pm	Camper pick-up (every family will receive a designated time slot)
