What You Will Do:

Lifeguards provide safety supervision, emergency response, leadership and service excellence to the members who use the pool.

Specific Responsibilities Include:

- Greet each member, participant, potential member, volunteer and staff with a smile using their name whenever possible. Deliver a high level of customer service. Engage in friendly, open dialogue with members and guests.
- Represent the YMCA in a responsible and professional manner.
- Provide assistance and information to each member, participant, potential member, volunteer and staff.
- Work efficiently and proactively with all departments to ensure excellent communication regarding all programs and services.
- Have an excellent working knowledge of the YMCA programs and brochure.
- Ensure the safety of all patrons in the pool area. Continuous safety supervision and emergency response.
- Keep the deck clean of all debris. Ensure a healthy and safe environment.
- Report missing first aid kit and fanny pack contents to Team Leader.
- In proper YMCA uniform.
- Make sure pool tests are taken every 2 hours, reporting any abnormalities to the Maintenance Department.
- Check to make sure that all rescue materials are in good working order on a daily basis.
- Stats are kept up to date and documented on the proper sheet.
- Educate the members and patrons on the pool regarding water safety rules.
- Attend staff trainings and in-services. Maintain a current skills passport.
- Arrive at least 15 minutes before your shift.
- Walk through of change rooms, checking for cleanliness and reporting issues to the Maintenance department.
- Keep the deck clean by squeegee during your shift. All hair and band aids should be picked up off deck and out of drains.
- Commitment to and demonstration of the YMCA core values.
- Create a fair, fun, and inclusive atmosphere.
- Work as part of a team to ensure a clean and well maintained facility at all times.
- Identify and create opportunities to enhance each and every person's YMCA experience.
- Other duties as assigned.

What you will bring to the position:

- Clear Vulnerable Sector Check
- Minimum 16 years of age
- Current Nation Lifeguard Certification
- Current Standard First Aid, CPR "C", and AED.
- Experience working as a lifeguard is considered an asset.

- Exposure to heat and humidity
- Wet floors on pool deck
- Requirement of Standard First Aid and CPR
- Clear Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector check
